Important Registration Information

Registration for the upcoming spring season will be held on Tuesday, March 4 from 6:00pm-8:00pm at all Mayfield and Graves County Elementary Schools. Late registration will be on Saturday, March 8 from 9:00am-12:00pm at ExpoIndoor II located at the Mayfield/Graves County Fairgrounds.

Players are placed on teams according to the school they attend on a first come, first served basis beginning at 6:00pm on March 4th. Registrations cannot be submitted before 6:00pm.

** You do not have to register your child for soccer at the school your child attends in order for them to play with the kids from that school. There is a place on the registration form for you to list which school your child attends. **

GCSA is continually striving to make soccer enjoyable for the kids and since we began placing kids on teams according to their school, we have received many positive comments from both players and their parents. This helps parents with transportation problems to practices and games and it also helps players prepare to play as a team for their middle school and high school soccer teams.

WHAT DO I NEED TO PLAY SOCCER?



Every child with the exception of Kindersoccer and TOPS will need a uniform which includes a reversible jersey (red/royal), shorts and one pair of socks. The cost of the uniform kit is \$25 and order forms will be available at registration. If your child has played soccer in the last two years and can still wear their uniform, you do not have to purchase a new one.

Shin guards are required for U6 and up. These can be purchased at Wal-Mart or Hibbett. Soccer cleats are not required but they are recommended. They can not have the cleat on the center front. Baseball cleats are not acceptable.

Each child is expected to bring a soccer ball to every practice (U6 and up). Ball size is determined by the child's age: U6/U8 – Size 3, U10/U12 – Size 4, U14 and up – Size 5

All practices and games will be played at Hamilton Park. Take Hwy. 58 and turn right at World Tower (formerly Upton's Cabinets) onto Golo Rd. Go approximately 1 mile and the fields are on the right. Practice dates and times will be up to each coach. Most team will practice 1 or 2 times per week.
