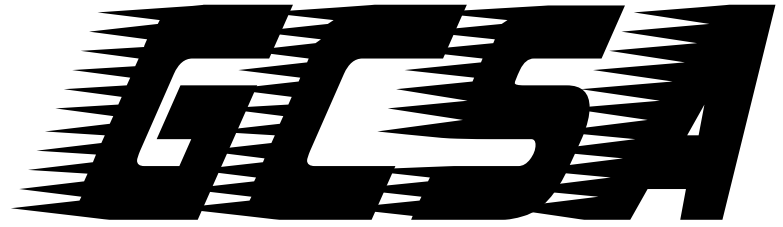

We are committed to making sure any child in the Mayfield and Graves County area who wants to play soccer may do so regardless of family income. This past spring GCSA teamed up with the YMCA and held a charity dinner and auction. All proceeds from this auction were divided equally by both organizations. All money we received from this was put aside to help children who want to play soccer but are unable to pay the registration fee and/or the cost of the uniforms.

In order to receive financial assistance, certain criteria must be met. There will be scholarship applications available at all registrations along with requirements necessary to qualify. All applications submitted must be approved by the GCSA board. If your child or any child you know would like to play soccer, but due to financial hardship is unable to do so, please let us know by filling out the application and applying for the scholarship.

A LEARN TO PLAY SOCCER PROGRAM FOR KIDS AGES 3 AND 4 YEARS

Our kindersoccer program is designed as an introduction to the game of soccer. Our coaches provide fun drills to teach the children to listen to instructions, follow directions, be part of a team, and learn good sportsmanship while learning basic soccer concepts. Boys and girls are placed on teams together at this age. In addition to the instructions, micro games will be held on their scheduled date.

Kindersoccer is new and improved this year, thanks to our new kindersoccer coordinator, Melissa Haley. So, if your child is 2 1/2 yrs old or didn't turn 4 until August 1st, 2006 or later, this would be a great way for them to learn to play the game!

The uniform order forms are also available on the website. If you are mailing in

your registration from, you will need to go to ww.gcysa.net and download a uniform order form and mail it with your registration form. Your uniform kits are \$20 each.

Shin guards are required for U-6 and up. These can be purchased just about anywhere. Soccer cleats are not required but they are recommended. They must not have the cleat on the center front. Baseball cleats are not acceptable.

Each child is expected to bring a soccer ball to each practice (U-6 and up). Ball size is determined by the child's age: U-6/U-8 - Size 3, U-10/U-12 - Size 4 over U-12 - Size 5.

All practices and games will be played at Hamilton Park. Take Hwy. 80 East and turn right at Uptons Cabinets. Go about 1 mile and the fields are on the right. Most teams will practice 1 or 2 times per week.

GCSA is pleased to announce the appointment of Edwin Odipo Nyamwala as director of player development. His roles will include weekly training of players in all age groups of GCSA. He will also work closely with coaches of both recreational and competitive teams to help develop a better base of qualified coaches. Edwin, a Kenyan native, has played soccer all of his life. He was captain of his high school soccer team which won three consecutive high school championships. Edwin continued his career in the United States played with Mid Continent University where he was recognized with several distinguished awards including being named to the NAIA/NSCAA All American team. Edwin is still today the all time leading scorer at MCU. Edwin also holds a National D coaching License and a National Soccer Coaches Association of American Coaches certificate. Edwin wants to encourage players to take advantage of the facilities and opportunities they have at their disposal, since so many kids around the world aren't as fortunate.

GCSA is a non-profit organization that organizes both outdoor and indoor soccer for children in Mayfield and Graves Co. as well as the surrounding area.
